Starting Times	Morning Session - 9:00 AM Afternoon Session - Will not start before 12:00 PM
Sanctioned by	Southern California Swimming Sanction #08-126
Location	Ventura College , 4667 Telegraph Road, Ventura, CA 93003
	Take 101 North to Victoria Avenue. Exit Victoria, go right on Victoria Avenue 13/4 miles to Telegraph Road. Turn left, school is on the right, pool is located by the softball fields. Use West Campus entrance.
Course	50 meter x 25 yard pool with 7-8 Competition lanes and warm-up/warm-down area available. Glass containers not allowed on pool deck.
Meet Referee	Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be directed to that person.
Warm-up	Swimmers must be under the supervision of an USA Swimming member coach for warm-up. Practice starts or diving from either the starting blocks or the pool edges are not allowed during warm-up. At the discretion of the Meet Referee, lanes 2 & 7 may be designated as sprint lanes (practice starts under coaches supervision with one-way swimming from the blocks) and lanes 1 & 8 may be designated for push-pace work (times TBA). Marshals will enforce the warm-up procedure and pool.
Rules	USA Swimming rules will govern. Current SCS meet procedures will be used and take precedence over any errors or omissions in this form. (see 2008 SCS Swim Guide) The Meet Referee will be in charge of the meet. Swimmers must check-in with the Clerk of Course for each event entered that they wish to swim. After an event has been officially closed, swimmers MAY NOT CHECK IN OR SCRATCH . Swimmers in the first 4 events must check-in at least 40 minutes prior to the start of the meet.
Eligibility	Open to athletes who are 2008 USA Swimming registered. Registration application must be received by the meet host or SCS office prior to the first day of the meet. REGISTRATION APPLICATION MAY BE SUBMITTED TOGETHER WITH ENTRY FORM . There are substantial penalties to the swimmer and the Club (see 2008 SCS Swim Guide, Part One, III, 8) if registration is completed at meet.
Change of Affiliation	Before the meet, a swimmer may change his/her affiliation by submitting a Club Transfer Form and appropriate fee to the Swim Office. At the meet, a swimmer may only UNATTACH (not attach or reattach) by notifying the Meet Secretary in writing and paying the appropriate fee.
Submitted Times	Submit best recorded long course meter times from this or the preceding swim season. Do not use practice or estimated times. Do not enter NT (no time) for events with a qualifying time. If a swimmer does not have a recorded time, but is otherwise qualified, that swimmer may enter at the minimum time (See Swim Guide for exceptions). SWIMMERS ARE LIMITED TO 4 EVENTS PER DAY . Swimmers entering OPEN events must be at least 11 years old and have achieved the minimum time listed.
Swimwear	The swimwear worn for all age group competitions shall conform to USA Swimming rule 102.9, and shall not extend past the top of the shoulder (acromial process) nor further down the leg than the top of the kneecap (patella).
Entry Fee	Use one white SCS consolidated entry card per swimmer to enter this meet. Card must be filled out completely including entire USA Swimming registration #. \$2.75 per INDIVIDUAL EVENT plus a \$5.50 surcharge per SWIMMER. MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA SWIMMING (SCS). A check for the total amount must accompany each entry to the address below. You may enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope or postcard to confirm receipt of entry. NO REFUNDS. ALL RETURN CHECKS WILL INCUR A SERVICE FEE.
Electronic Entry Procedure	E-mail entry (entry.zip file) will be accepted only when received with an attached Word or .pdf file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time. (5 PM postmark would queue before a 10 PM electronic) Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY . New swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE. DO NOT RESEND AN ENTRY FILE : A replacement file for the team will NOT be processed. Deletions will NOT be refunded.
Entries Close	Entries must be postmarked by May 27, 2008 or Hand-delivered by May 28, 2008.
Awards	Awards will be given out in 2 divisions per event. The divisions will be based on the number of swimmers entered in each event with the fastest 50% of the entries competing in the blue division and the remaining swimmers in the WHITE division. Top 6 finishers in each division will receive an award. If there are fewer than 6 swimmers in an event, there will only be one division.
